On the 22 February, the trial of ex-Priest Richard Daschbach is scheduled to start in the Oecusse District Court. Mr. Daschbach is formally accused of 14 counts of sexual abuse, child pornography and domestic violence.

This trial is a result a two-and-a-half years process. It has been a turbulent and challenging process for everyone involved, including the criminal authorities, women organizations, the Oecusse community and specially the survivors.
