UN backs inquiry into killings

The UN will investigate allegations that East Timorese Prime Minister, Mari Alkatiri, is linked to the deaths of several soldiers. Rebels have alleged that Alkatiri was directly linked to the killings during a May 2006 demonstration, as well as to the massacre of 12 unarmed police during the week ended 2 June. The Prime Minister has been accused of triggering recent violence in East Timor after he sacked 600 soldiers and ignored divisions within the defence force. UN special representative, Sukehiro Hasegawa, says **Alkatiri** has agreed to comply with the **investigation**
